**COURT RULE FOR COMPENSATION OF COURT APPOINTED  
SPECIAL JUDGES**

WHEREAS, it has been the accepted practice that the Chief Judge of the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Court appoint Special Judges when the judges of the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Court are disqualified to preside over a case before the Court, or when the Chief Judge finds, in the interest of justice, that a Special Judge should be appointed to preside over a case before the Court, and

WHEREAS, a uniform rate of compensation for such Special Judges needs to be established, now therefore, the following rate is established by Amended of Court Rule 17-06:

In consideration of the services performed Special Judges shall be paid One Hundred dollars(\$100) per hour to preside over cases assigned by the Chief Judge to administer justice and discharge all duties imposed by law pursuant to the Constitution and Law and Order Code of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe.

Special Judges shall be paid Sixty dollars (\$60) per hour for travel time to perform duties of Special Judge.

Special Judges shall be paid mileage for use of the vehicle to the prevailing federal rate for travel to and from Rosebud, or other trips necessary to complete the business of the court.

The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Court, On October 1, 2017, hereby adopts this local court rule pursuant to RST Constitution Article XI Sec. 4.
