## **COURT FILING FEES**

Fees Charged by Clerk of Courts – Rosebud Sioux Tribal Departments exempt from filing fees. The Clerk of Courts shall charge and collect the following fees:

- 1. Civil cases filed for court or jury trial--\$25.00
- 2. Guardianship or conservator actions--\$25.00
- 3. Probate--\$25.00
- 4. Adoptions--\$25.00
- 5. Complaint to establish paternity, custody, child support and visitation--\$25.00
- 6. Complaint for divorce--\$40.00
- 7. Name change--\$20.00
- 8. Small Claims--\$20.00
- 9. Complaint for temporary/permanent restraining order--\$25.00
- 10. Background check--\$75.00
- 11. Records search--\$25.00 for each record search conducted if the search is requested by a person not a party named in the action for which the search is requested. A separate fee shall be charged for each name for which the record search is requested. The Clerk may not charge a search fee if the request is made by a party to the case or by an attorney of record or any member of the attorney of record's law firm or staff.
- 12. Service of process fee for each person or entity being served--\$15.00
- 13. Copies/per page--.50 Cents

- 14. Faxes/per page--\$1.00
- 15. Notary fees--\$1.00 for non-case related notarization

Any of the above fees may be waived for an indigent party upon Motion for Waiver of Filing and Service of Process Fees and the Court's Order granting the motion pursuant to Court Rule 17-04.
