MOTION TO STAY SENTENCE OR ORDER OF PROBATION PENDING APPEAL

Use the attached form motion if you have appealed your conviction to the Tribal Supreme Court you can ask the Court to stay your sentence pending your appeal. The Tribal code allows the Court in its discretion to stay a sentence of imprisonment where you would have to post a bond. It also allows the Court in its discretion to stay a sentence to pay a fine or costs or an order of probation. A stay means the sentence or order of probation will be suspended pending your appeal. If any imprisonment is stayed pending appeal, you will have post a bond before being released pending appeal.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING OUT THE FORM. To fill out the attached form follow these instructions. The numbers to each instruction below is the number on the blank line on the form where the information for that number needs to be inserted on the form.

Instructions for filling out the motion:

- (1) on this line insert your name. If you are charged with a crime(s) you are the defendant.
- (2) on this line insert the date you were sentenced by the Court.
- (3) on this line insert how many days jail and how much was the fine and costs or probation you were sentenced to.
- (4) on this line insert the date you filed you appeal. Also attach a copy of your notice of appeal.
- (5) on this line explain any circumstances of why the Court should stay your sentence or probation pending it appeal. This could include employment, need to care for a child or disabled adult, breast-feeding, a medical condition
- (6) on this line insert the date you sign the motion
- (7)on this line sign the motion
- Note: Your motion must be signed and dated before the Clerk can accept it for filing and service (8) on this line date the day you mailed a copy of the motion to the RST Prosecutor's office. You
- are required to serve a copy of the motion on the RST Prosecutor's office.
- (9) on this line sign your name to certify you mailed a copy of the motion on date you inserted on line (8).

NOTE: You must file your motion with the RST Clerk of the Criminal Court and mail a copy to Tribe's Prosecutor's office.
